


So come, take a peak inside and see for yourself what the woodland presents...



The Nest, a home in the woods

Within the Glade is an insulated, all-weather structure made from local timber and renewable materials designed by our friends the Workshop Collaborative.

It's 7m in diameter, and has space to seat around 24 adults inside, as well as usable floor space. It is insulated, has a wood burner and part of it comes off (to make a stage/performance space).

Whether you're teaching bushcraft, leading nature therapy sessions, using the woods as an outdoor gym, singing in nature, or would just like to take your indoor activities outdoors... The Glade provides a space to meet, teach, learn and be inspired by the woods.

What's available?

The Glade is more than the Nest. We also have a star tent, some parachute canopies, outdoor cinema kit and more. These are available for use at an extra fee.

- An 11m star tent - provides a sheltered outdoor spot, for messier/bigger functions
- Parachute Canopies - we can erect these between the trees
- Storage space - for kit and equipment
- Outdoor cinema kit
- Lighting options
- Pop-up bar
- Fire circle
- Tables

Pricing

The following prices cover the hiring of The Glade event space, The Nest and Fire Circle. This also includes access to parking, and use of the compost loo.

The Nest is available 7 days a week, from morning until evening. There is a half an hour grace period for setting up/departing the site in addition to the hire period (i.e. 1 hour hire = 1 hour 30 mins total, including 15 mins setup and 15 mins departure).





Booking

- 1** Check the calendar on the website to see which dates are available.
- 2** Contact us to confirm availability
- 3** We'll send you a link to a form where you can specify your event requirements.
- 4** Pay for your booking. This is required within 24hrs unless other arrangements have been made.

We will advertise your course/event on our website, social media and newsletter. We will then arrange to meet with you at the site so we can help settle you in properly.

Please arrive up to 15 mins before the start of your booking. Meet, teach, learn and enjoy your Nest experience. Once finished leave the building and car park within 15 minutes after the end of your session... Leave the site as you found it. Come back soon!


Finding us

The Nest is situated in Parsonage Copse in the North Woods, on the western edge of the Dartington Estate, South Devon. The closest town is Totnes.

We encourage users of the Nest to lift share, or even better leave the car at home and arrive by bike, or on foot. Doing so enables a change of pace to occur, prior to arriving at the site.





Be immersed

The Nest experience begins as soon as you enter the woods, and immersing yourself fully into it will put you on a more peaceful wavelength. We invite you, and your participants, to make the most of this change of pace by really paying attention to the details and sensory imprints of the forest.

- Breathe mindfully as you walk
- Listen to the welcoming bird song
- Look out for the types of trees that surround you
- Stop, drop and flop: Arrive at North Woods early, find a place you like the look of and sit for a while
- Pick up an object that catches your eye (stone, flower, feather) and carry it with you to the site
